Wine Profile

Robust flavors and exceptional texture, the wine is characterized by Strawberry-Rhubarb flavors followed with herbaceous notes of thyme. Our goal is to create a wine that showcases the varietal's exceptional character in this region.

Palate Impressions

Dense and packed with great acidity and structure, this wine is very fresh. The fruit is so pure it gives the impression of sweetness even though the wine is technically dry. The vineyards were more balanced in 2016, bestowing the wines of this vintage with high levels of concentration and detailed aromatics.

Vineyard Context

Sunchase Vineyard is situated on the Southeastern edge of the Sonoma Coast appellation at 800 ft elevation. Considered one of the top five vineyards in Sonoma County, Sun Chase consistently produces wines of great depth and complexity. The rocky hillside soils of this hillside gem are derived from volcanic parent material known as basalt which has a low concentration of magnesium but very rich in minerals which is ideal for cultivating premium Pinot Noir grapes.
