Tasting Notes

In 2022, the central coast of California enjoyed nearly perfect weather for grape growing, avoiding the erratic patterns seen in the North. This mild climate, neither too cool nor too hot, allowed for superb phenolic development in the grapes. The result is one of our finest Soberanes vintages ever!

This wine is silky smooth, well-rounded, and lush, with juicy notes of red currant and strawberry, complemented by beautiful hints of violet. As with all our Soberanes vintages, it features a mid-palate presence of spices, including white pepper and clove. This wine is incredibly well-balanced, with soft tannins and a velvety finish. Enjoy!

Vineyard Context

Nestled up against the bench-land hills, the Soberanes Vineyard is located in the heart of the Santa Lucia Highlands. This family owned vineyard has perfect drainage and abundant filtered sunshine that allows these grapes to ripen perfectly and evenly throughout the growing season.
